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EMPLOYMENT QUESTIONNAIRE

APPLICANT'S NAME

It is the goal of the Administration and Board to select and employ mature Christian teachers who approve of, and are willing to function under, general Christian guidelines. To this end, you will be asked to appear before a joint meeting of the Faculty and Christian Education and Curriculum Committees where you will be requested to give a brief account of your Christian experience. In preparation for your appearance before these committees, it is requested that you answer the following questions which the Administration and Board feel are important to an evaluation of your qualifications.

1. Please share with us your own Christian testimony; i.e., your acceptance of Christ, significant growth experiences, your church life, etc.
2. Please provide us with your personal view of the Bible as to its purpose, authority, accuracy and your own private study of it.
3. How would you share Christ with a student?
4. What are some of the Scriptures you would use?
5. Do you believe that you can take the Bible and apply it to your teaching field?
6. Give a brief example of how Biblical truth and revelation can be applied to the subject (s) you would like or expect to teach, if employed.
7. Are you willing to engage in further study to learn to apply Biblical truth to your field?
8. Name three books you've read over the past year and explain why they were important to you. (Either professionally or personally.)
9. Describe your approach to teaching (with specific reference to your subject area if secondary). Explain how your approach would be compatible in a K-12 Christian college preparatory school.
10. What is your view of the role of discipline in a Christian school?
11. How would you handle the situation if you caught – without doubt – a student cheating in your class? Suppose the student was a person who was involved in representing the school in a very important extra-curricular activity, such as athletics, or band, or involvement in a play?
12. If you lost your temper in class, how would you handle the situation?
13. In what ways do you believe that a Christian school should be different from other private schools?
14. Why do you want to teach at a Christian school and at First Presbyterian Day School in particular?
