



Why enroll in the FPD dining plan

Healthy food fuels healthy minds for classroom work and after school activities!

Meals served are made from scratch on the day the food is served.

Organic options are served as often as possible including sustainable, locally sourced food. Some from FPD's own gardens!

Food served contains no MSG, partially hydrogenated oils, artificial trans fats, or LFTB.

Clean label food served. Clean label means the food is composed only easily recongnizable ingredients, nothing articificial.

Gluten free, allergen free, and vegetarian options available every day.

What's on the Menu?

Daily Food

- Two homemade entrees with vegetables, including a steamed green option, along with rice, potatoes, or pasta.
- Classic Cuts Deli Bar with homemade hummus, housecarved meats, and other delicious sandwich toppings.
- Self-serve "Improvisation Station" salad bar with fresh cut fruits, vegetables, local lettuces and house-made composed salads and dressings.
- Clean label, house made pizza (Fridays only)
- Homemade Soup
- Baked desserts (Fridays only)

Drinks

• Choice of tea, milk, water, spa water, or juice.

- Unlimited seconds on every menu item
- Monthly special buffets featuring unique cuisine
- Other specials including panini stations, baked potato bar, waffle bar, smoothie station, and more.

Frequently Asked Questions

How are fees assessed?

Dining fees are billed in equal installments from September - May and appear on the family billing statement.

How are Dining Passes used?

Each student in 6-12 grade on the Dining Plan will be issued a Dining Pass. The student is responsible for his or her pass and should present it in the Dining Hall. A student who forgets his/her pass may purchase a new permanent pass for \$10 in the Viking Store.

What if a field trip conflicts with lunch?

If a student is enrolled in the Dining Plan and is scheduled to take a school field trip, the Sage Dining staff will prepare a packed lunch, if ample notice is provided by the teacher.

May I change my plan?

Yes. Parents must give the Business Office a written notice 30 days in advance.

Will I receive a credit if my child is absent from school and misses lunch?

If a Dining Plan enrolled student misses more than five consecutive days, some concession can be made on the monthly fee. Parents are encouraged to contact Kay Sexton in the Business Office if this situation occurs.

What if my child is not on the Dining Plan and forgets his/her lunch?

Have your child go to the Viking Store to receive a daily pass. Your child will enjoy the same food and benefits as the students on the Dining Plan. The fee for the daily pass is \$8 to \$10 per day depending on your child's grade level and will be added to your family billing statement.

May I eat with my child in the Dining Hall?

Yes! We love for parents and grandparents to join us. Please check in with the Viking Store or the Elementary School office for a Visitor Pass for \$8.

Does the Senior Off-Campus privileges conflict with lunch?

The Dining Plan rate is reduced for seniors. There is no concession to the plan for senior students who opts for off-campus privileges. Most opt for the three-day plan.

Is lunch provided on Early Dismissal days?

Students in grades 1-5 who are enrolled in the Dining Plan may participate in lunch on the days when grades 6-12 are released early and prior to mid-terms or finals.
