

2021 FPD Consignment Sale

June 22-23, 2021

This annual event allows FPD parents to purchase/sell gently used school uniforms and other FPD items at a discounted rate. Parents can consign Lands' End uniforms, any item purchased in The Viking Store and other school related items such as cheerleading uniforms, spirit shirts, etc. *Please note that Sunshine brand items can no longer be worn nor consigned.* Sellers receive 70% of the selling price. The consignment sale will be held in the Middlebrooks Athletic Center (MAC), which is the same building the cafeteria is located. Please review the following pages for more information. Consigning is easy:

- Create seller code unless you already have one issued from The Viking Store (see page 2).
- Price your items (see the separate file for pricing suggestions).
- Attach seller tags (download the separate file and print tags). Items can not be accepted if not tagged properly.
- Drop off items at the MAC Lobby during hours/days posted below.
- Shop the sale!
- Pick up unsold items that you do not want to donate between 10am-1pm on Thursday, June 24th. Items not picked up that day will be considered donated to FPD.
- Checks, for any items sold, will be mailed approximately 2-3 weeks after the sale. Please leave mailing address on sign-in form when dropping off items.

For security reasons, we ask that items with any FPD logo not be donated locally. Any FPD item can be donated to the school at any time during the year by dropping them by The Viking Store or any school office. A tax donation letter can be issued, if desired. Questions: vikingstore@fpdmacon.org.

BASIC CONSIGNMENT GUIDELINES

SELLER CODES: Seller codes are very important! This unique ID should be placed on every one of your tags. If you do not have a seller code previously issued from The Viking Store, please use the following method.

Seller Code: First initials of your first and last name and the last two digits of your birth year.

For example, Elaine Benes born in 1980 would be EB80.

TAGGING INFORMATION: The seller tags allow volunteers to easily determine how your items will be classified if not sold on the full price sale day. Properly secured tags also ensure that you will receive any money you are due. Tags can be downloaded and work best on card stock. Blank tags and safety pens will be available for your convenience on drop-off days. Tags should be safety pinned on the upper right side of the hanging item. ON THE SELLER TAGS, PLEASE CIRCLE YES OR NO REGARDING HALF PRICE AND DONATED ITEMS. IF THESE ITEMS ARE NOT MARKED, THEY WILL BE SOLD AT HALF-PRICE AND THEN DONATED, IF NOT SOLD.

HANGING/BAGGING INSTRUCTIONS: All clothing must be on hangers, with the garment facing you and the hook facing left. Pant hangers with clips are required. PLEASE DO NOT USE CLOTHES PINS OR STRAIGHT PINS TO HANG PANTS/SKORTS/SHORTS. Please make sure the tags are safety pinned securely on the upper right side of the hanging items. Items such as hair accessories, jewelry, etc.. should be placed in a sealable plastic bag and the sellers tag placed inside the bag. If the tag falls off an item, we will not be able to identify the seller and you will not receive money for the item(s).

DROP OFF DAYS: Please drop items off at The Viking Store located in the MAC building. When dropping off your consignment items, please make sure to fill out the information on the sign-in sheet with name, consignment number, and mailing address. Blank seller tags will be available at that time, if needed. Please allow a few minutes for the drop-off process.

CONDITION OF ITEMS: Items with stains and holes do not sell. However, you may place these items in the salvage basket. These items can be used for replacement buttons, etc. (Note: Long pants with damaged knees can be cut off to make shorts for someone.)

INDEMNITY: By willingly submitting items into the sale, the consignor acknowledges that risks are involved, including theft or damage to the consigned items. Consignor agrees to hold FPD, its employees and agents harmless in the event of lost, stolen or damaged items.

*Items may be donated to FPD at any time during the year.
Simply leave them at any school office or The Viking Store.*
